- County spends millions for vehicles almost every year for maintenance for vehicles and vehicles
- Study done in Canada for different rust proofing systems; Corrosion Free has 95% reduction in corrosion
- Given the ongoing problem with deterioration of County vehicle fleet, proposing trial program to maintain fleet
- Suggesting this to save money

Mr. Ryan asked if this is something fleet management is endorsing, and what is the product. Mr. Jordan answered that it is a spray on process. The Canadian government wanted to maintain their fleet to keep in good condition, so they did a study on all processes available. This was by far the best process. The US government piggybacked on the study and will be implementing it for the military.

Mrs. Ervin asked if this is for new vehicles, is the County buying new vehicles this year. Mr. Jordan replied yes, that is part of what the committee is proposing. Chairman Knapp stated there are new vehicles for WEP.
