- Resource sharing within parks have 71 full time employees another 100 part time every park and building is open could always do more with more employees
- Pre COVID still working with austerity able to get some employees back County Executive has been great to get us resources all pre COVID full time employees have been called back

Mr. Stancyzk:

• A lot of Park departments contributed – discouraging to get phone calls with negative complaints – offsets all the positive comments - started 24 years ago there were seven employees at the Hatchery – now there are two – figure out how to do things more efficiently and prioritize

- Answered Ms. Kuhn's question regarding difficulty for families coming in from out of town to do the Tuesday thru Thursday burial cross training so others can pick up the slack
- Answered Ms. Cody's question regarding summer internships have them but less than prior years because of less demand
